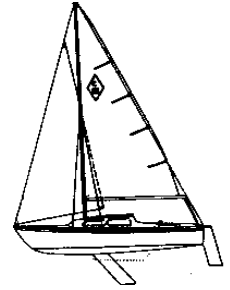

Notice of Race



Hosted by: Fleet 96 of Dixie Sailing Club

Date: March 20 and 21, 2010

Rules: The races will be governed by *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012* and the Catalina 22 One Design Class Rules (non-spinnaker). Gold Fleet and Silver Fleet entries must be current members of C22NSA and reside in Region 3.

Races: Five races are scheduled, of the windward/ leeward variety. One race will constitute a regatta. Scoring will be low point as per Appendix A with all races counting towards the final results. No score will be excluded, this changes RRS A2. Full Sailing Instructions handed out at registration.

Venue: The Dixie Sailing Club, Lake Martin, Alabama

Entry Fee: \$45 - this fee includes one Sat evening dinner, and a hat for the skipper. Additional meals and hats may be ordered when registering. Bag lunches for Sat may also be purchased. In addition, racers visiting DSC for this event can enter the DSC Punchbowl regatta on April 10 & 11 with no additional entry fee, just the cost of meals ordered. Storage in DSC boatyard (next two weekends) until that regatta is free on a space available basis.

Awards: Number of Gold Fleet and Silver Fleet awards depend on number entered - plan is 1st thru 3rd for each fleet!

Radio Use: VHF radios are NOT required, but could be brought in case they are used by the race committee to communicate racecourse activity - e.g. weather, delays, etc.

Additional Info: DSC's spacious facility has ample land area, and a concrete paved ramp making it easy for everybody to dry sail their boats. A limited size camping area with hook ups is available.
